Since 2015, the Our Part Food Program at Green Creek Bethel United Methodist Church has helped combat childhood hunger in Cape May County by providing weekend food bags for children when school meals are not available.

To date, the program has distributed **more than 37,000** food bags to local children in need. **During the 2025-2026** school year, more than 5,500 bags were provided, serving approximately **170 children each week** in four local elementary schools.

Operated entirely by volunteers, the program is supported by generous individuals, churches, businesses, civic organizations, school staff, and community partners. **100% of every donation is used to purchase food for the children we serve.**

History

Bethel United Methodist Church was organized in 1850. The one-room church, heated by a wood stove and lighted by lamp, is still in use on the original lot. A vestibule and belfry were later added and the roof raised. The lamps were converted to electricity but are still in use. The bell, tolled each Sunday, was installed in 1881. The pews were purchased in 1910 and the stained glass windows were added in 1925. The elaborately carved walnut altar furnishings were made in 1889 and received in 1967 from Trinity Methodist Church in Pennsville. The sanctuary was air-conditioned in 1968 and our social hall was constructed in 1975. The social hall and downstairs newly renovated classrooms were air conditioned in 2007. Ever since its beginning, the church has touched and transformed the lives of countless men and women. Our mission is to continue the ministry entrusted to us and to share the Gospel with others.
